4. Title: Animal shelters; penalties

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill exempts animal shelters located in the City of Virginia Beach from inspection by the State Veterinarian, certain recording requirements, operating in accordance with regulations issued by the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and civil penalties. Currently, all animal shelters may be assessed a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 for a violation of the regulations or this section.
