Summary/Purpose:** The bill amends and reenacts the second enactment of Chapter 1010 of the Acts of Assembly of 2000, as amended by Chapter 407 of Acts of Assembly of 2001, and amends and reenacts the second enactment of Chapter 727 of the Acts of Assembly of 2001, all providing for civil penalties for violations of regulations relating to the confinement and disposition of animals by animal shelters. The effective date for all of the specified civil penalties is delayed until January 1, 2003. The bill contains an emergency clause .
