**4. Title:** Oconeechee State Park

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill authorizes the Department of Conservation and Recreation to amend a lease with the Secretary of the Army for the purpose of providing additional recreational facilities at Oconeechee State Park in Mecklenburg County.

**6. Fiscal Impact:** See Item 8.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** None

**8. Fiscal implications:** Visitorship at Oconeechee State Park will increase as a result of the construction of a golf course in the immediate area. However, it is not possible to discern how revenues at the park will be affected.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Department of Conservation and Recreation, Mecklenburg County

**10. Technical amendment necessary:** None

**11. Other comments:** The property upon which Oconeechee State Park sits is owned by the Army Corps of Engineers. The purpose of the legislation is to amend the lease in order to provide the Department of Conservation and Recreation with the authority to sublease a portion of the property to Mecklenburg County for the construction of a golf course.
