5. Summary/Purpose: The bill revises the legal name of the Medical College of Hampton Roads to be consistent with its commonly accepted popular name, i.e., "Eastern Virginia Medical School" and strengthen sand modernizes the school sauthorities and status in the Code of Virginia. The bill includes numerous technical amendments to change the institution's legal name in the enabling chapter, the Code, and to update the language of the enabling chapter regarding operation of the Medical School. In addition, the bill includes a nemergency clause.

6. NoFiscalImpact.

- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** Yes. IfthisbillisadoptedbytheGeneralAssemblyseveral namechangesintheBudgetBillwillneedtobechanged.
- **8. Fiscalimplications:** Theagencyhasindicatedthattherewillbenocosttothe Commonwealthalthoughminimalcostswillbeincurredtoim plementthenamechange. The MedicalSchoolwillincursomecostsforchangingthesealoftheschool, newletterhead, new businesscards, aswellasminorcoststoconsolidateallcorporatenames under the Eastern Virginia Medical Schoolname.

 $This bill \ changes then a me of the agency from the Medical College of Hampton Road stoits more commonly referred to name of Eastern Virginia Medical School. In addition, the bill clarifies several items relating to governing and operating the Medical School: \\$

- 1) the boardofvisitorstakeofficeonJuly1oftheappointmentyear;
- 2) therectororanythreemembersmaycallspecialmeetingsoftheboardandtheboardmay appointanexecutivecommitteeofatleastthreememberstotransactbusinessintherecessof theboard;
- 3) theschoolmayoperateandownmedicalandhealthcare,education,researchandassociated programsandestablishsatelliteofficesandfacilitiesforsuchprogramswithinorwithoutthe CommonwealthortheUnitedStates;
- 4) theboardofvisitorshasauth oritytocontractwithdomesticandforeignentitiesforits activities; and
- 5) theboardofvisitorshasauthoritytoobtainpatents,copyrights,andtrademarksfor intellectualpropertiesandtoadminister,manage,market,transfer,andconveyanyinterest suchintellectualproperties.

The billals oprovides exceptions, parallel to those exceptions provided for public institutions of higher education or the public medical schools, from the prohibited contracts provisions of the conflicts of interest law, and there cords disclosure and closed meeting provisions of the Freedom of Information Act. Finally, the bill reinforces the fact that the Administrative Process Act and the Public Procurement Act do not apply to Eastern Virginia Medical School, which, although established in law, is not apublic institution of higher education.
