The billals oprovides exceptions, parallel to those exceptions provided for public institutions of higher education or the public medical schools, from the prohibited contracts provisions of the conflicts of interest law, and the records disclosure and closed meeting provisions of the Freedom of Information Act. Finally, the bill reinforces the fact that the Administrative Process Act and the Public Procurement Act do not apply to Eastern Virginia Medical School, whi although established in law, is not apublic institution of higher education.
