4. Title Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA); electronic communication meetings

5. Summary/Purpose:

Extend the exemption of certain public bodies from the FOIA's electronic communication meeting restrictions from July 1, 2002, to July 1, 2004. The exempted entities are (i) any public body (a) in the legislative branch of state government or (b) responsible to or under the supervision, direction, or control of the Secretary of Commerce and Trade or the Secretary of Technology or (ii) the State Board for Community Colleges. The bill also extends from April 15, 2001, to April 15, 2003, the filing date for submitting a report detailing these entities' experience with meetings held under this pilot program.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: This legislation will extend the time that affected parties are exempt from filing requirements to comply with certain provisions of the Freedom of Information Act relating to electronic communications. There is no fiscal impact on state agencies.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: The Secretariat of Commerce and Trade, Secretariat of Technology, and the State Board for Community Colleges.
