4. Title Property conveyance; Frontier Culture Museum.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill authorizes the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services (DMHMRSAS) to convey to the Frontier Culture Museum of Virginia (Museum) approximately 78.3 acres in Augusta County upon terms and conditions DMHMRSAS deems proper, with the approval of the Governor and in a form approved by the Attorney General. The parcels are described as DeJarnette Parcel 2 (17.593 acres) and Western State Parcel 2 (60.762 acres) properties located in the northeast intersection of Interstate Routes 64 and 81 in Augusta County.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Not available.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill transfers approximately 78.3 acres of unimproved real property from DMHMRSAS to the Museum. Both parcels of land are considered surplus and this action will have no fiscal impact on DMHMRSAS. In addition, the Western State parcel is currently landlocked and it can only be accessed through the Museum.

At this time, the Museum does not anticipate the need for general fund support or to develop or maintain the property. The Museum anticipates using private sector funds or non-general fund revenue to develop the property.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Frontier Culture Museum and the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services.
