Summary/Purpose:Thisbilldirect stheBoardofEducationtodevelopguidelinesforlocal schoolboardstoawardverifiedunitsofcreditforastandarddiplomafor"transition"students: studentsenteringtheninthgradeinthe2000,2001,and2002schoolyearsusingcriteriadifferent fromthecurrentStandardsofAccreditationdiplomarequirements.Theguidelinesaddress studentsintheseclasseswhopassedtherelevantcourseworkandwhomeetsuchadditional criteriaastheBoardshallestablishfortheawardofsuchverifiedunits,wh ichmayinclude,but shallnotbelimitedto,performanceonStandardsofLearningassessmentsorothertests, includingsubsequentadministrationsofsuchassessmentsortests;attendanceandconduct requirements,andparticipationinremediationprograms

Theguidelines are applicable only to the award of the four student -selected verified units of creditinequired for a standard diploma pursuant to the Standards of Accreditation (SOA) (8VAC 20-131-50B). Students must still earn the two verified units of creditin English for a standard diploma as provided in the Standards of Accreditation. The guidelines is sued by the Board shall not be subject to the Administrative Process Act (§2.2 -4000 et seq.) and apply, retroactively and prospectively, to student sentering then in the grade for the first time in 2000, 2001, and 2002.

Whenawardingsuchcredits, theBoardmustestablish aformulathatrecognizesthatastudentmayearnverifiedcreditbasedupontestperfo rmance incombinationwiththestudent'send -of-coursegrade. Thisformulawouldapplytocases wherethestudenthasre -takentheStandardsofLearningassessmentandhasscoredwithin theestablishedmarginoferror. Theformulawouldbeapplicableto studentsenrolledin gradessixthroughninein2001 -2002.
