The bill provides that the Compensation Boardwillbear the cost of the benefits. The Compensation Board is currently limited in its cost by language in the Appropriations Act. The total cost for the benefits is approximately \$31.6 million in FY04. Currently, localities may provide special benefits for lawen forcement of ficers with benefits equivalent to those of state police of ficers (LEOS) to deputies.
