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## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 62.1-44.38:1, relating to
 3 development of state, regional and local water supply plans.

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### Approved

### 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-44.38:1 as follows:

**8** § 62.1-44.38:1. Comprehensive water supply planning process; state, regional and local water **9** supply plans.

10 A. The Board, with the advice and guidance from the Commissioner of Health, local governments, 11 public service authorities, and other interested parties, shall establish a comprehensive water supply 12 planning process for the development of local, regional and state water supply plans consistent with the 13 provisions of this chapter. This process shall be designed to (i) ensure that adequate and safe drinking 14 water is available to all citizens of the Commonwealth, (ii) encourage, promote, and protect all other 15 beneficial uses of the Commonwealth's water resources, and (iii) encourage, promote, and develop 16 incentives for alternative water sources, including but not limited to desalinization.

B. Local or regional water supply plans shall be prepared and submitted to the Department of
Environmental Quality in accordance with criteria and guidelines developed by the Board. Such criteria
and guidelines shall take into account existing local and regional water supply planning efforts and
requirements imposed under other state or federal laws.

21 2. That the State Water Control Board shall promulgate regulations necessary to carry out the 22 provisions of this act, including criteria for the development of local and regional water supply 23 plans. Such regulations shall not become effective prior to July 1, 2004. Draft criteria for the 24 development of local and regional water supply plans shall be prepared and submitted to the 25 Governor, the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources, the House 26 Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources, and the State Water Commission 27 by December 1, 2003.

3. That the State Water Control Board shall prepare and submit to the Governor, the Senate 28 29 Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources, the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources, and the State Water Commission, by December 30 31 1, 2003, a preliminary state water resources plan in accordance with § 62.1-44.38, which includes 32 information from existing local and regional water supply plans. The Department of Health and 33 all other state agencies shall assist in the preparation of the state water resources plan, and water 34 supply systems shall provide available information, including existing water supply plans, as 35 needed to develop the preliminary state plan.

36 4. That the Water Policy Technical Advisory Committee, established jointly by the State Water 37 Commission and the Department of Environmental Quality in 2002, shall work with the 38 Department of Environmental Quality and the Virginia Department of Health on the development 39 of the plan, criteria, guidelines and regulations required by this act and shall advise these agencies 40 on any further changes needed to the Commonwealth's water resources policies and programs.

5. That the provisions of this act shall have no effect, positive or negative, on any water supply project for which a permit application was submitted prior to January 1, 2003, to any state or federal agency. The provisions of this act shall have no effect, positive or negative, on any water supply project for which an application for grant, loan or other funding has been made to a state or federal agency prior to January 1, 2003.
