That § 51.1-124.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 12 § 51.1-124.3. Definitions. 13 As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning: "Abolished system" means the Virginia Retirement Act, §§ 51-30 through 51-111, repealed by 14 15 Chapter 1 of the Acts of Assembly of 1952. "Accumulated contributions" means the sum of all amounts deducted from the compensation of a 16 member and credited to his individual account in the member's contribution account, all amounts the 17 member may contribute to purchase creditable service, all member contributions contributed by the 18 19 employer on behalf of the employee, on or after July 1, 1990, except those amounts contributed on 20 behalf of members of the General Assembly who are otherwise retired under the provisions of this 21 chapter, and all interest accruing to these funds. If a member is retired for disability from a cause which is compensable under the Virginia Workers' Compensation Act (§ 65.2-100 et seq.), dies in service prior 22 to retirement, or requests a refund of contributions in accordance with § 51.1-161, "accumulated 23 24 contributions" shall include all member contributions paid by the employer on behalf of the member on 25 and after July 1, 1980, and all interest which would have accrued to these funds. 26 "Actuarial equivalent" means a benefit of equal value when computed upon the basis of actuarial 27 tables adopted by the Board. 28 "Average final compensation" means the average annual creditable compensation of a member during 29 his thirty-six highest consecutive months of creditable service or during the entire period of his 30 creditable service if less than thirty-six months. If a member ceased employment prior to July 1, 1974, 31 "average final compensation" means the average annual creditable compensation during the five highest 32 consecutive years of creditable service. 33 "Beneficiary" means any person entitled to receive benefits under this chapter. 34 "Board" means the Board of Trustees of the Virginia Retirement System. 35 "Creditable compensation" means the full compensation payable annually to an employee working 36 full time in his covered position. In cases where compensation includes maintenance or other perquisites, 37 the Board shall fix the value of that part of the compensation not paid in money. Remuneration received by members of the General Assembly not otherwise retired under the provisions of this chapter pursuant 38 39 to §§ 30-19.11 and 30-19.12 shall be deemed creditable compensation. In addition, for any member of the General Assembly, creditable compensation shall include the full amount of salaries payable to such 40 41 member for working in covered positions, regardless of whether a contractual salary is reduced and not paid to such member because of service in the General Assembly. 42 43 The creditable compensation of a teacher shall equal the full compensation payable annually to such teacher by his county, city, or other local public school board. Such full compensation shall include all 44 compensation payable to such teacher by his public school board that is not pursuant to a contract for 45 46 teaching. 47 "Creditable service" means prior service as set forth in § 51.1-142.2 plus membership service for 48 which credit is allowable. 49 "Employee" means any teacher, state employee, officer, or employee of a locality participating in the 50 Retirement System. 51 "Employer" means the Commonwealth in the case of a state employee, the local public school board 52 in the case of a teacher, or the political subdivision participating in the Retirement System. 53 "Joint Rules Committee" means those members of the House of Delegates and the Senate designated 54 by the Speaker of the House and the Chairman of the Senate Committee on Rules, respectively, to meet 55 with each other and to act jointly on behalf of the Committee on Rules for each house. "Local officer" means the treasurer, commissioner of the revenue, attorney for the Commonwealth, 56 57 clerk of a circuit court, or sheriff of any county or city, or deputy or employee of any such officer. 58 "Medical Board" means the board of physicians as provided by this chapter.

59 "Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System.

60 "Membership service" means service as an employee rendered while a contributing member of the61 Retirement System except as provided in this chapter.

62 "Normal retirement date" means a member's sixty-fifth birthday.

<sup>63</sup> "Political subdivision" means any county, city, or town, any political entity, subdivision, branch, or
<sup>64</sup> unit of the Commonwealth, or any commission, public authority, or body corporate created by or under
<sup>65</sup> an act of the General Assembly specifying the powers, privileges, or authority capable of exercise by the
<sup>66</sup> commission, public authority, or body corporate.

67 "Primary social security benefit" means, with respect to any member, the primary insurance amount
68 to which the member is entitled, for old age or disability, as the case may be, pursuant to the provisions
69 of the federal Social Security Act as in effect at his date of retirement, under the provisions of this
70 chapter except as otherwise specifically provided.

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"Prior service" means service rendered prior to becoming a member of the Retirement System.

"Purchase of service contract" means a contract entered into by the member and the RetirementSystem for the purchase of service credit by the member as provided in § 51.1-142.2.

"Retirement allowance" means the retirement payments to which a member is entitled.

75 "Retirement System" means the Virginia Retirement System.

76 "Service" means service as an employee.

"State employee" means any person who is regularly employed full time on a salaried basis, whose 77 78 tenure is not restricted as to temporary or provisional appointment, in the service of, and whose 79 compensation is payable, no more often than biweekly, in whole or in part, by the Commonwealth or any department, institution, or agency thereof. "State employee" shall include the Governor, Lieutenant 80 Governor, Attorney General, and members of the General Assembly but shall not include (i) any local 81 officer, (ii) any employee of a political subdivision of the Commonwealth, (iii) individuals employed by 82 the Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired pursuant to § 51.5-72, (iv) any member of the State 83 Police Officers' Retirement System, (v) any member of the Judicial Retirement System, or (vi) any 84 member of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System. 85

86 "Teacher" means any person who is regularly employed full time on a salaried basis as a professional87 or clerical employee of a county, city, or other local public school board.

2. That the provisions of this act shall be applicable to compensation payable to a teacher by hispublic school board on and after July 1, 2003.
