4. Title Claims; relief for Daniel M. Zacharias.

5. Summary/Purpose:

The bill provides for the payment of \$12,000 from the Onsite Sewage Indemnification Fund to Daniel M. Zacharias as compensation for installing an alternative waste disposal system required for a lot purchased in Mount Jackson, Virginia. Mr. Zacharias purchased the lot based on the report of a private Authorized Onsite Soil Evaluator indicating that the lot would support an onsite sewage disposal system and that the lot was located in a subdivision that had previously been approved for septic systems by the Virginia Department of Health. In accordance with the *Code of Virginia* and following the purchase of the lot by Mr. Zacharias, a subsequent review of the lot by VDH determined that the lot would not support the system and that an alternative system was required.
