Electronicequipmentrecyclingprogram.Require stheDepartmentof EnvironmentalQualitytoadoptregulationstoprovideforanelectronicequipment recyclingprogram. The bill requires the program to work with local governments and businessesindetermininghowtorecycleelectronicequipmentandtop romote recyclinganddonatingelectronicequipment. The billals or equires the Department, by July 1,2004, to develop a list of electronic equipment and organizationsthatacceptitfordonationorrecycling.BeginningJuly1,2004, the bill bansthed is posal of cathoder ay tubes in mixed solid waste, prohibits solidwastemanagementfacilitiesfromacceptingcathoderaytubes, and only allowsdisposalofcathoderaytubesinaccordancewiththeDepartment's regulations. Forpurposes of this bill, "catho deraytube"meansanintact glasstubeusedtoprovidethevisualdisplayintelevisions, computermonitors, oscilloscopesandsimilarscientificequipment, and "electronicequipment" means devices that contain complex circuitry, circuit boards or signal processing, and that contain hazardous materials that may pose a risk to public healthortheenvironmentifdiscardedaspartofmixedsolidwasteordisposed ofinasolidwastemanagementfacility. Electronic equipment includes, but is notlimitedto,c athoderaytubes,computers,televisionsandcellphones.
