Directsthe Virginia Research and Technology Advisory Commission (VRTAC), in conjunction with the Secretaries of Technology, Commerce and Trade, and Education, to develop strategies for research and development in the Common wealth. - **8. Fiscalimplications:** Theintroducedversionofthisbillcalledforthedevelopmentofa comprehensivestrategicplan, which would be expected to cost between \$150,000 and \$300,000. The engrossed bill modifies this requirement, and instead calls for the development of strategies, which CIT reports that it can coordinate with existing staff resources. Thus, this version of the bill should not have any fiscal implications.
