## 8. Fiscalimplications:

The bill creates three new collegial bodies and increases the membership in another. Fiscal implications are as follows:

- NewCommissionandElectricUtilityRestructuring. Thenewbodyhasthesamenumberofmembersas theLegislativeTransitionT askForceitreplaces.Ifthenewbodyholdsthesamenumberofmeetingsasthe TaskForce,fiscalimpactshouldbeneutral.
- **NewConsumerAdvisoryBoard.** Thenewbodyistohaveeightnonlegislativemembers,andreplacesthe 17-memberboardthatassist stheLegislativeTransitionTaskForce,whichisabolishedinthisbill.Sincethe newbodyhasfewermembers,costsformeetingswillbesomewhatless,assumingthesamenumber of meetingsheld.Savingsareestimatedat\$11,400annually,assumingfour meetingsayearandthatall membersattendeachmeeting.
- NewVirginiaDelegationtotheMultistateTaxAdministrationDiscussions. Thenewgroupistohave fivelegislativemembersandtomeetatleastfourtimesannually,foracostofabout\$6,120annu ally (includingperdiempaymentstomembers,travel,andlodging,andmeals)assumingallmembersattendeach meeting.
- Additional members in the Virginia Roanoke River Basin Advisory Committee.Thebillincreases membershipfrom18to21,includingone additionalnonlegislativememberandfouradditionalexofficio members. Assuming the committees meets sixtimes annually, and that all members attende a chmeeting, the additionalcost(includingperdiempayments,travel,lodging,andmeals)isestimate dat\$4,500annually. Inaddition, other costs may be associated with this bill to the extent that it may require an agency to provide financial support to a collegial body that the agency is not now supporting. Given the number of collegial bodiesinclu dedinthebill, itisnotpossibletodeterminewhetherthebill would change the source of support for each. Forthemostpart, the bill appears to simply clarify current practice in terms of such support. However, at least one agency indicates thatthebillwouldrequireittoprovidefinancialsupportfora collegialbodythatitdoesnotnowsupport. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) reports that the billrequiresittoprovidefinancialsupporttotheVirginiaRoanokeRiverBasin AdvisoryCommittee. Assuming the committee meets six times annually, and that all members attende a chmeeting, the costs to DEQ areestimatedat\$32,400annually.(Thisestimateassumesperdiempaymentsof\$200forlegislativemembers and\$50forother s,\$150permeetingformeals,and\$100perpersonpermeetingfortravelandlodging.) Overall, fiscal impact is roughly estimated at \$27,120, factoring in increased costs of new collegial bodies withsavingsinanother.Fullimpactcannotbedeter minedatthistime.
