5.	Summary/Purpose:SenateBill749amendstheCodeofVirginiabydirec DepartmentofSocialServicestoestablishapilotsubsidizedguardianshipp benefitofchildreninthecustodyofalocalboardofsocialservicesorotherch agencywhoarelivingwithrelativecaregiversandwhohavebeeninfosterca				

ingthe rogramforthe ldwelfare rlivingwith reo relativesotherthannaturalparentsforatleast18months.Arelativecaregivermeansa personwhoiscaringforachildrelatedtosuchpersonforwhomtheoptionofreunification hasbeeneliminatedandterminationofparentalrightsis notappropriate. The subsidized guardianshipprogramshallprovideforaspecial -needsubsidy,whichshallincludeaone timelump -sumpaymentforexpensesresultingfromtheassumptionofcareofthechild,a medicalsubsidycomparabletothatinadoptio n.andamonthlysubsidyonbehalfofthechild payabletotherelativecaregiver. The monthly subsidy shall be equal to the prevailing foster carerate. The department may establish an assettest for eligibility under the program. Prior totheguardian shiphearingandpaymentofaguardianshipsubsidyforthebenefitofaminor child, a homestudy report on the relative caregivers hall be filed with the court having jurisdictionoverthechild'scasewithin15daysoftherequestforasubsidy.Therel ative caregiverreceivingaguardianshipsubsidyshallsubmitannuallytothedepartmentasworn statementthatthechildisstillliving with and receiving support from the guardian. Once the subsidyisgranted, it continues until the child is 18 or 21 i fafull -timestudent.

8. Fiscalimplications: Thisbillestablishesapilotsubsidizedguardianshipprogram. Thebill createstwoprimaryservicegroups. The first group is the children infoster careforwhich the goalist oplace them with relatives. These cond group is thos echildren on Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) as child -only cases.

### FosterCareRelativePlacementCosts :

Therewere325children(fourpercentofthetotalinfostercare)withthegoalofplacement witharelativeasofSeptember2002.Re lativecaretakerswithcustodymayapplyforand receiveTANFforchildrenintheircare.However,themovefromfostercaretoTANF programstatuswoulddroptheaveragemonthlypaymentfrom\$393to\$118perchild.The costtomaintainthesecasesatth efostercarepaymentlevelissimplythecostoftheexisting fostercarepayments(\$1,532,700).Currently,50.53percentofthiscostisbornbythefederal IV-Efostercareprogram.Sinceitisveryunlikelythatthefederalgovernmentwouldgrant VirginiaaTitleIV -Ewaiver(referredtointhebill),thesecostswouldhavetobeassumedby eitherTANForgeneralfunddollars.Thenetannualcostforthispopulationissimplythe foregoneIV -Ereimbursementof\$774,473.Virginia'sTANFgrantisfull yappropriatedand therefore,thiscostwouldhavetobecoveredwithgeneralfundmonies.

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#### TANF"ChildOnly"CaseCosts :

In2002, therewere9,061TANF"childonly"cases. Althoughmostof the TANF"child only"cases would not have gone through the foster caresystem, the language of the bill may be ambiguous enough to expand the covered guardian ship to all "childonly" cases. The amount of the TANF payment amount varies by the three assistance level groupings of local departments as well as the number of relative child renin the family and the child's income, if any. Using a TANF payment of \$118 per case permonth and an average foster family rate, the monthly cost difference per case is \$275. To provide the same level of financial support to guardians of the sechild renwould thus cost approximately \$29,901,300 more than current TANF payment ents a scalculated below. Again, because Virginia's TANF grant is fully appropriated, this cost would have to be covered with general fund resources.

#### OtherCosts :

Thebillalsocoversotherchildwelfareagencies.Wehavenostatisticsonhowmany childrenmightpotentiallybeappropriatef orthisprogramfromtheseagencies.

Inadditiontothemonthlysubsidy,aportionofwhichcouldbefundedbyTANF,thereisa one-timeinitialpaymentaswellasmedicalsubsidy.Medicaid,FAMIS,andState -Local Hospitalizationwouldlikelycoverapor tionofthesechildren,butnotall.Theconditions andrestrictionsoftheone -timesubsidyandmedicalsubsidyarenotaddressedinthebill. Basedontheaverageone -timelumpsumof\$477paidinthediversionaryassistanceprogram fortransportation, housing,andotherneeds,andprojectingthat10percentofthecases annuallywillrequestaone -timegrant,atotalof\$432,162isestimated.Anadditional \$200,000isrequestedformedicalcostsnotcoveredbyothermedicalsubsidyprograms.

### PilotPro gramAssumptions

Thedepartmentassumesthatthisprogramwouldbepilotedinfivelocalitiesinorderto estimatethecostofthislegislation.Astatewidecostofthesubsidiesmustbecalculatedfirst andthenthepercentageoflocalitiesparticipating inthepilotappliedtothetotalstatewide costofthesubsidies.Thetotalstatewidecostforthesubsidiesinthisguardianshipprogram is\$31,307,935(\$774,473fostercarerelativesubsidies+\$29,901,300TANFchild -only subsidies+\$432,162lumpsum payments+\$200,000uncoveredmedicalcosts).The percentageofthetotaldepartmentsparticipatinginthepilotis4.1percent(fiveoutof121 totaldepartments)therebyyieldingacostof\$1,283,625forthesubsidiesinapilotprogram thatoperatedi nfivelocalities.

### AdministrativeCosts

Thedepartmentestimatesthatitwillneedonefull -timeemployeeinthecentralofficeto managethepilotsubsidizedguardianshipprogram. The central office employee will be a ProgramAdministrationManagerII( payband5).Themanagerwilldevelopandprovide outreachduringyear1andadministerthesubsidiesduringyeartwoandthereafter.Usinga mid-rangesalaryof\$53,278forpayband5,salaryandbenefitswilltotal\$69,388annually. Fundstocoverthe routineoperatingcostsofpostage,office,travel,supplies,telephone,rent, liabilityinsurance,etc.areestimatedat\$7,900peremployee.One -timecoststotaling\$6,500 peremployeeareincludedinthefirstyearforofficefurnitureandequipment. Significant automatedsystemchangeswouldbenecessarytoboththeADAPTandOASISsystems. Thesecostsareestimatedat\$500,000forvearoneand\$100,000pervearthereafter. Personnel, equipment, printing, and support coststotal \$87,788 in FY04 an d\$78,288inFY 05.
