5. **Summary/Purpose:** The substitute version of the bill T heBoardofEducationshallpromote theknowledgeandappreciation of diverser acial and ethnic cultures, and language minority populations, particularly such cultures and populations represented in the public schools of the Commonwealth.TheBoardshalle stablishguidelinestoassistlocalschoolboardsin implementingculturaldiversitypoliciespursuantto§ 22.1-86.2. The Boardshall identity best practices within and outside of the Common wealth. Each school boards hall promote the knowledgeandappreciationofdiverseracialandethniccultures, and languageminority populations in the public schools. As chool board shall establish cultural diversity policies that are consistent with guidelines established by the Board of Education. The boards of visitors of each public institution of higher education in the Common wealth shall submit an equal education opportunityplanthatincludes, ataminimum, the institution's objectives ,strategy,andinitiatives toimprovediversityamongstudents, faculty, and administrative and supportstaff. The plans shallbesubmittedtotheGovernor,GeneralAssemblyandtheStateCouncilofHigherEducation forVirginia(SCHEV)byNovember1each year.TheStateBoardforCommunityCollegesshall submitanequaleducationopportunityplanfortheVirginiaCommunityCollegeSystemthat includes, ataminimum, the Board's objectives, strategy, and initiative sto improved iversity amongstudents,fa culty,andadministrativeandsupportstaffthroughouttheSystem.Theplan shallbesubmittedtotheGovernor,GeneralAssemblyandSCHEV.Thesubstituteincludesa  $sunset clause that ends the required submission of plans by the boards of visitors after {\it the required submission}. \\$ July1, 2008.(Note:Remainingresponses are related only to the higher education portion of this legislation.)
