UniformPartnershipActstatements.Establishesthe requirementsforrenewing a statement of partnership authority filed with the State Corporation Commission, andclarifiesotherprovisionsoftheUniformPartnershipActregardingthefilingof statements of partnership authority, dissociation, dissolutio n,andmerger. The filing of arenewal will restart the 5 -yeareffectivelifeofastatement ofpartnershipauthority. A statement of partnershipauthority must be amended wheneverthepartnershipchangesitsname. A statement of partnership authority mustbefiledpriortothefilingofastatementofdissociationor dissolution. Statements of merger must be executed by each party to the merger, and are only effective as to a partner ship that has a statement of partnershipauthorityonfilewiththeComm ission. Finally, the measure provides that the term "statement," for purposes of the Uniform Partnership Act, includes are new alofa statement of partnership authority.
