10	utility disruptions in urban areas in the Commonwealth during severe weather conditions, including
11	hardship occurring during the recent hurricane; and
12	WHEREAS, placing underground the currently existing overhead utility distribution lines and any
13 14	new utility distribution lines would reduce the number of weather-related utility disruptions; and WHEREAS, placing underground the currently existing overhead utility distribution lines and any
15	new utility distribution lines may reduce utility line maintenance costs; and
16	WHEREAS, placing underground the currently existing overhead utility distribution lines and any
17	new utility distribution lines would minimize the visual pollution in the Commonwealth; now, therefore,
18	be it
19	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the State Corporation
20	Commission be [directed requested] to study the placement of utility lines underground in urban areas.
21	The State Corporation Commission shall [study solicit the participation of interested parties in
22	conducting a study of] the feasibility of placing underground the currently existing overhead utility
23	distribution lines and any new distribution lines, the costs that would be incurred, and the options for
24	funding such underground placement.
25	The State Corporation Commission shall submit to the Division of Legislative Automated Systems an
26	executive summary and report of its progress in meeting the directives of this resolution no later than
27	the first day of the 2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly. The executive summary and report
28	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
