11	each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same
12	hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next
13	general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
14	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
15	Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X as section numbered 8-A as follows:
16	ARTICLE X
17	TAXATION AND FINANCE
18	Section 8-A. Appropriations not to exceed revenue; exceptions.
19	No appropriation shall be made, nor any expenditure authorized by the General Assembly, whereby
20	the expenditure of the Commonwealth, during any fiscal year, shall exceed the total revenue then
21	provided for by law and applicable for such appropriation or expenditure, unless the General Assembly
22	making such appropriation shall provide for levying a sufficient tax to pay such appropriation or
23	expenditure within such fiscal year. This provision shall not apply to appropriations or expenditures to
24	suppress insurrection, defend the Commonwealth, or assist in defending the United States in time of
