Authorizing the painting and hanging of a portrait of Ford C. Quillen, former Speaker of the House of Delegates; allocating funding thereof.

WHEREAS, Ford C. Quillen has dedicated his life to public service, including 23 years as a member of the House of Delegates and eight years as a judge of the Thirtieth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, while serving as Chairman of the House Committee on Privileges and Election, Ford C. Quillen became acting Speaker of the House of Delegates on September 28, 1991, and performed his duties with distinction until November 19, 1991; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That this body hereby authorize the painting of a portrait of Ford C. Quillen, such portrait to hang in the Chamber of the House of Delegates; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That there is hereby allocated from the general appropriation to the House of Delegates a sum sufficient to cover the cost of such portrait; and, be it

RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Speaker shall appoint a committee composed of three members of the House of Delegates and the Clerk of the House of Delegates to select an artist who shall render the portrait and to exercise general supervision of the project until the portrait has been hung in the Chamber.
