# 5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires the Department of General Services, in coordination with the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, to establish a statewide contract for telephonic language interpretation services and other interpretation and translation services to Virginia's limited Englishspeaking residents, if it determines that such a contract is cost-effective.
