4. Title Statewide Translation Contracts

5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires the Department of General Services, in coordination with the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, to establish a statewide contract for telephonic language interpretation services and other interpretation and translation services to Virginia's limited English-speaking residents, if it determines that such a contract is cost-effective.

6. Fiscal impact could not be determined (see Item 8).

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: This proposal requires the Department of General Services and Secretary of Health and Human Resources to establish a statewide contract for language interpreter services. To negotiate and establish the contract, there will be a small administrative cost that the affected agencies should be able to absorb in existing programs. Conversely, use of statewide translation contracts could result in savings to state agencies.
