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| 9 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 10 | 1. That §§ 2.2-2686 and 2.2-2689 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 11 | § 2.2-2686. (Effective until July 1, 2008) Duties of the Council. |
| 12 | A. The Council shall have the following duties: |
| 13 | 1. Recommend a timetable for phasing in and establishing guiding principles for the Roadmap; |
| 14 | 2. Recommend long-term objectives for the Commonwealth and monitor and advise the Governor |
| 15 | and the General Assembly regarding the progress toward the objectives; |
| 16 | 3. Provide advice on the implementation of the performance-management system across state |
| 17 | government; |
| 18 | 4. Disseminate information to the public on the Commonwealth's performance-management system; |
| 19 | 5. Recommend a systematic process for the periodic evaluation of the Roadmap and adherence to the |
| 20 | long-term goals and recommend improvements to the Governor and the General Assembly. The periodic |
| 21 | evaluation process shall provide for enhanced opportunities for public participation and input; |
| 22 | 6. Beginning November 1, 2004, develop and submit annually to the General Assembly and the |
| 23 | Governor and publish to the public a balanced accountability scorecard containing an assessment of (i) |
| 24 | current service performance, (ii) productivity improvement, and (iii) progress against long-term |
| 25 | objectives. The balanced scorecard shall also contain other evaluative recommendations that will enhance |
| 26 | the provision of state services and suggested measures to evaluate progress against long-term objectives; |

| 28 | 7. Solicit public input on appropriate aspects of the Roadmap as determined by the Council; and |
| 29 | 8. Examine the efficiency and effectiveness of the operation of state agencies and recommend actions |
| 30 | for reducing costs, improving efficiency and effectiveness and facilitating better performance from state |
| 31 | agencies. |
| 32 | B. By January 1, 2004, the Council shall recommend to the Governor and the General Assembly |
| 33 | legislation defining the vision, long-term objectives, and appropriate performance measures for state |
| 34 | government. The Council shall review the long-term objectives for state government every two years. |
| 35 | § 2.2-2689. (Effective until July 1, 2008) Chairman's executive summary of activity and work of the |

| 37 | A. The chairman shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual executive |
| 38 | summary of the interim activity and work of the Council no later than the first day of each regular |
| 39 | session of the General Assembly. The executive summary shall be submitted as provided in the |
| 40 | procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents |
| 41 | and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website. |

| 43 | Governor and General Assembly including its findings regarding the efficiency and effectiveness of the |
