That §§ 2.2-2686 and 2.2-2689 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:</li> <li>§ 2.2-2686. (Effective until July 1, 2008) Duties of the Council.</li> <li>A. The Council shall have the following duties:</li> <li>1. Recommend a timetable for phasing in and establishing guiding principles for the Roadmap:</li> <li>a. Provide advice on the implementation of the performance-management system across state downment.</li> <li>a. Provide advice on the implementation of the performance-management system across state forcement.</li> <li>a. Disseminate information to the public on the Commonwealth's performance-management system:</li> <li>b. Recommend a systematic process for the periodic evaluation of the Roadmap and adherence to the fong-term goals and recommend improvements to the Governor and the General Assembly.
