That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 38.2-228.2 as follows: § 38.2-228.2. Certain medical malpractice claims to be reported to the Commission. All medical malpractice claims settled or adjudicated to final judgment against a person, corporation, firm, or entity providing health care and any such claim closed without payment during each calendar year shall be reported annually to the Commission by the insurer of the health care provider. The reports shall not identify the parties. The report shall state the following data, to the extent applicable, in a format prescribed by the Commission: Nature of the claim and damages asserted; Principal medical and legal issues; Attorneys' fees and expenses paid in connection with the claim or defense to the extent these amounts are known; Attorneys' fees and expenses reserved in connection with the claim or defense; The amount of the settlement or judgment awarded to the claimant to the extent this amount is known; The specialty of each health care provider; The date the claim was reported to the company; The date the claim was closed; The date the claim as closed; The date and amount of the initial reserve; The date negative as the insurer if different from the amount of settlement or judgment awarded to the claimant; and Any other pertinent information the Commission may require as is consistent with the provisions of this section.
