8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Governor is authorized to request federal funds to expand the capacity of the
10	Sitter-Barefoot Veterans' Care Center located in Richmond, Virginia, by an additional 80 beds. After the
11	United States Department of Veterans Affairs has confirmed that it has officially accepted the
12	application of the 80-bed expansion, the State Treasurer shall advance a loan of \$2,800,000 to the
13	Department of Veterans Services for the state share of the expansion's construction in the form of a
