4. Title: Medical care facilities certificate of public need.

Summary/Purpose: This bill requires the Commissioner of Health to reissue a Request for Applications for 60 new nursing home or nursing facility beds in Planning District 12 when the scheduled construction date has passed, the company issued a certificate pursuant to a 1997 Request for Applications has not begun construction, and the certificate has expired. The Commissioner may give preference to an applicant who was denied the certificate under the 1997 RFA and who proposes a new facility in the county seat of the county in which the nursing facility granted the previously-issued certificate is located.
