Summary/Purpose:** The bill would provide that regulations adopted by the Board of Housing and Community Development in accordance with Chapter 138 of the Acts of Assembly of 2004 (relating to the use of natural cut Christmas trees in the common areas of places of worship and in apartment dwelling units that do not have automatic sprinkler systems) shall remain in full force and effect until a regulation to replace the emergency regulation is adopted in accordance with the Administrative Process Act of the Code of Virginia or July 2006, whichever occurs first.
