15	§ 2.2-2609. Blue Ridge Regional Tourism Council; membership; meetings; Blue Ridge defined.
16	A. The Blue Ridge Regional Tourism Council (the "Council") is established as an advisory council,
17	within the meaning of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The Council shall be
18	composed of one representative of each of the destination marketing organizations (DMOs) located in
19	the Blue Ridge region and the President of the Virginia Tourism Authority.
20	B. The Council shall elect a chairman and a vice-chairman from among its members. The Council
21	shall meet at least four times a year at such dates and times as they determine.
22	C. For the purposes of this article, the "Blue Ridge" region shall include the Counties of Alleghany,
23 24	Amherst, Appomattox, Augusta, Bath, Bedford, Bland, Botetourt, Campbell, Craig, Floyd, Franklin, Giles, Highland, Montgomery, Nelson, Pulaski, Roanoke, Rockbridge, and Wythe and the Cities of

27	§ 15.2-6202. Duties of Authority; governmental functions.
28	A. The Authority shall provide financial support (i) for the purchase of real estate, construction of
29	buildings for sale or lease, installation of utilities and any other support improvements it deems
30	necessary, including flood control dams, and (ii) for direct loans and grants to private for-profit basic
31	employers. The Authority shall also apply for matching funds from the state or federal government, or
32	the private sector. All such loans and grants may be managed by the Fifth Planning District
33 34	Commission. B The everyise of the powers granted by this chapter shall be in all respects for the banefit of the
34 35	B. The exercise of the powers granted by this chapter shall be in all respects for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Commonwealth, particularly the County of Alleghany and the City Town of Clifton
36	Forge; for the increase of their commerce; and for the promotion of their safety, health, welfare,

40	§ 15.2-6203. Board of Authority; members and officers; staff; annual report.
41	A. All powers, rights and duties conferred by this chapter, or other provisions of law, upon the
42	Authority shall be exercised by the Board of the Alleghany-Highlands Economic Development
43 44	Authority, hereinafter referred to as the Board or the Board of the Authority. Initial appointments shall begin July 1, 1993. The Board shall consist of seven members as follows: one representative of each of
45	the region's governing bodies, or their designees, who shall be appointed by the respective governing
46	bodies and shall be residents of the region; four at-large members, who shall be appointed by the
47	Governor and shall be residents of the region; and one member to be appointed by the Executive
<b>48</b>	Director of the Virginia Economic Development Partnership. However, all appointments made after July
<b>49</b>	1, 2005, shall be made solely by the participating governing bodies, in a manner agreed to by the
50	governing bodies. All members shall serve for a term of four years and may be reappointed for one
51	additional term. For the initial appointments only, two of the four at-large members shall be appointed
52 53	for two-year terms and such initial terms shall not be counted toward the term limitation.
53 54	B. Each member of the Board shall, before entering upon the discharge of the duties of his office, take and subscribe to the oath prescribed in § 49-1. Members shall be reimbursed for actual expenses
54 55	incurred in the performance of their duties.
55 56	C. Four members of the Board shall constitute a quorum, and the affirmative vote of four members
57	of the Board shall be necessary for any action taken by the Board. No vacancy in the membership of
58	the Board shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of the

59 Board.

60 D. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman and a secretary-treasurer for each calendar 61 year. The secretary-treasurer shall keep the minutes of the Board and affix the seal of the Authority.

62 The Board may also appoint an executive director and staff who shall discharge such functions as 63 may be directed by the Board.

64 E. The Board, promptly following the close of the fiscal year, shall submit an annual report of the 65 Authority's activities for the preceding year to the Governor, the General Assembly, and the board of supervisors and eity councils town council of the Region. Each such report shall set forth a complete 66 operating and financial statement covering the operation of the Authority during such year. 67 68

§ 15.2-6209. Capitalization of Authority.

On or before January 1, 1994, and on or before the first day of each year thereafter, each county and 69 70 eity town that is a member of the Authority may remit to the Authority an amount it deems appropriate 71 for Authority purposes. 72

§ 15.2-6210. Proceeds held.

73 The secretary-treasurer may invest and reinvest funds of the Authority pending their need. All moneys received by the Authority pursuant to § 15.2-6208, together with any matching funds received 74 75 from state or federal sources, shall be applied and used only in the county or eity town from which the funds were received, unless the governing body of the county or eity town consents to their use in 76 77 another county, or city, or town. 78

§ 15.2-6214. Revenue sharing agreements.

79 Notwithstanding the requirements of Chapter 34 (§ 15.2-3400 et seq.) of Title 15.2, the County of 80 Alleghany and the City Town of Clifton Forge may agree to a revenue and economic growth sharing arrangement with respect to tax revenues generated by any industry, business or other for-profit 81 employment generating enterprise locating in any of the localities. The obligations of the parties to any 82 83 such agreement shall not be construed to be debt within the meaning of Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of Virginia. Any such agreement shall be approved by a majority vote of the governing 84 85 bodies of the localities reaching agreement but shall not require any other approval. 86

§ 16.1-69.6. Establishment of districts.

87 On and after July 1, 1973, the Commonwealth shall be divided into districts encompassing all 88 counties and cities in the Commonwealth to provide a basis for the sound and efficient administration of 89 the courts not of record, as follows:

(11) The City of Petersburg and the Counties of Dinwiddie, Nottoway, Amelia and Powhatan shall 106 107 constitute the eleventh district.

- 108 (12) The City of Colonial Heights and the County of Chesterfield shall constitute the twelfth district.
- 109 (13) The City of Richmond shall constitute the thirteenth district.
- (14) The County of Henrico shall constitute the fourteenth district. 110

111 (15) The City of Fredericksburg and the Counties of King George, Stafford, Spotsylvania, Caroline, Hanover, Lancaster, Northumberland, Westmoreland, Richmond and Essex shall constitute the fifteenth 112 113 district.

(25) The Cities of Covington, Lexington, Staunton, Buena Vista, Clifton Forge and Waynesboro and
the Counties of Highland, Augusta, Rockbridge, Bath, Alleghany, Botetourt and Craig shall constitute
the twenty-fifth district.

(26) The Cities of Harrisonburg and Winchester and the Counties of Frederick, Clarke, Warren,
 Shenandoah, Page and Rockingham shall constitute the twenty-sixth district.

(30) The City of Norton and the Counties of Wise, Scott and Lee shall constitute the thirtieth district.

(31) The Cities of Manassas and Manassas Park, and the County of Prince William shall constitutethe thirty-first district.

142 § 17.1-500. Establishment of circuit courts.

143 For the City of Williamsburg and James City County, and every other county in the Commonwealth, 144 and the Cities of Alexandria, Bristol, Buena Vista, Charlottesville, Chesapeake, Clifton Forge, Colonial Heights, Danville, Fredericksburg, Hampton, Hopewell, Lynchburg, Martinsville, Newport News, Norfolk, Petersburg, Portsmouth, Radford, Richmond, Roanoke, Salem, Staunton, Suffolk, Virginia 145 146 147 Beach, Waynesboro and Winchester, there shall be a circuit court, which shall be called the circuit court 148 of such county or city, or county and city, as the case may be. Each city circuit court shall be the sole 149 court of record for the city and have jurisdiction over each suit, motion, prosecution or thing now or 150 heretofore properly pending in the former courts of record of the city and over the records of such 151 courts<sub>7</sub>. Any reference in this Code or in any act of the General Assembly to a corporation, hustings, 152 law and chancery, law and equity, chancery or other court of record of a city shall apply to the circuit 153 court thereof, mutatis mutandis.

30. The City of Norton and the Counties of Lee, Scott and Wise shall constitute the thirtieth circuit.

205 31. The Cities of Manassas and Manassas Park and the County of Prince William shall constitute the 206 thirty-first circuit.

207 § 22.1-354.1. Western Virginia Public Education Consortium and board created; region defined; 208 governing board; chairman's executive summary.

209 A. The Western Virginia Public Education Consortium is hereby established and shall be referred to 210 as the Consortium. For the purposes of this chapter and the work of the Consortium, "Western Virginia" shall include the Counties of Alleghany, Bath, Bland, Botetourt, Craig, Floyd, Franklin, Giles, Henry, 211 Montgomery, Patrick, Pulaski, Roanoke, and Wythe, and the Cities of Covington, Clifton Forge, 212 213 Martinsville, Radford, Roanoke, and Salem. The governing board of the Consortium shall consist of 34 214 members that include 15 legislative members and the 19 school superintendents of the named localities 215 as follows: 11 members of the House of Delegates representing the Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth, and Nineteenth House Districts; four members of the 216 Senate representing the Twentieth, Twenty-first, Twenty-second, and Twenty-fifth Senatorial Districts, all 217 218 serving as ex officio nonvoting members; and the school superintendents of Alleghany and Clifton Forge, Bath, Bland, Botetourt, Craig, Floyd, Franklin, Giles, Henry, Montgomery, Patrick, Pulaski, 219 Roanoke County, Wythe, Covington, Martinsville, Radford, Roanoke City, and Salem. 220

221 B. Legislative members and school superintendents shall serve terms coincident with their terms of 222 office. The board shall elect a chairman and a vice-chairman from among its members.

223 C. Members of the board shall serve without compensation. All members shall be reimbursed for all 224 reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in the work of the Consortium as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. All such expenses shall be paid from existing 225 appropriations to or received by the Consortium or, if unfunded, shall be approved by the Joint Rules 226 227 Committee.

228 D. A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum. The board shall meet at the 229 call of the chairman or whenever a majority of the members so request.

230 E. The chairman of the board shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual 231 executive summary of the interim activity and work of the board no later than the first day of each regular session of the General Assembly. The executive summary shall be submitted as provided in the 232 233 procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents 234 and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website. 235

§ 24.2-302.1. Congressional districts.

236 A. There shall be eleven Virginia members of the United States House of Representatives elected 237 from eleven congressional districts and each district is entitled to representation by one representative.

238 B. All references in this section to counties and cities shall be interpreted to refer to those in existence on April 1, 2001, and as reported by the United States Bureau of the Census in the 2000 239 Census reports provided pursuant to United States Public Law § 94-171, notwithstanding subsequent 240 boundary changes by law, annexation, merger, consolidation, or the voiding of boundary changes 241 242 theretofore made final.

243 C. Parts of counties and cities listed in subsection D are defined by reference to the 2000 Census

reports for the precincts, parts of precincts, and blocks listed for each congressional district in the
Statistical Report on file with the Clerk of the Senate for the Act of Assembly containing the final
enactment of this section.

**247** D. The eleven congressional districts are:

248 First. All of Essex, Gloucester, King and Queen, King George, King William, Lancaster, Mathews, 249 Middlesex, Northumberland, Richmond, Stafford, Westmoreland, and York Counties; all of the Cities of 250 Fredericksburg, Poquoson, and Williamsburg; part of Caroline County comprised of the Bowling Green, 251 Port Royal, Woodford, and Mattaponi Precincts; part of Fauquier County comprised of the Kettle Run, 252 Catlett, Casanova, Lois, Morrisville, Remington, Opal, and Waterloo Precincts and part of the Baldwin 253 Ridge Precinct; part of James City County comprised of the Berkeley A, Berkeley B, Jamestown A, 254 Jamestown B, Jamestown C, Powhatan A, Powhatan B, Stonehouse A, Stonehouse B, Roberts A Part 1, 255 and Roberts A Part 2 Precincts and part of the Roberts B Precinct; part of Prince William County comprised of the Dumfries, Potomac, Graham Park, Quantico, Washington-Reid, and Rippon Precincts; 256 257 part of Spotsylvania County comprised of the Travelers Rest, Grange Hall, Plank Road, Summit, Frazers 258 Gate, Salem, Battlefield, and Brent's Mill Precincts and part of the Maury Precinct; part of the City of 259 Hampton comprised of the Kraft, Magruder, Northampton, and Tucker Capps Precincts and part of the 260 Burbank Precinct; and part of the City of Newport News comprised of the Richneck, Windsor, Boulevard, Christopher Newport, Watkins, Hidenwood, Palmer, Saunders, Yates, Kiln Creek, 261 262 Beaconsdale, Sedgefield, and South Morrison Precincts and parts of the Deep Creek, Hilton, Riverside, 263 and Warwick Precincts.

264 Second. All of Accomack and Northampton Counties; all of the City of Virginia Beach; part of the 265 City of Hampton comprised of the Lasalle, Phoebus, River, Syms, Wythe, Booker, Buckroe, Fox Hill, 266 Kecoughtan, Langley, and Phillips Precincts and part of the Burbank Precinct; and part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Northside, Titustown Center, Zion Grace, Canterbury, Crossroads, Larchmont 267 Library, Larchmont Recreation Center, Therapeutic Center, Wesley, Azalea Gardens, Barron Black, 268 Easton, Fairlawn, Houston, Bayview School, Bayview United, East Ocean View, Larrymore, Little 269 Creek, Ocean View School, Oceanair, Tarrallton, Third Presbyterian, Ocean View Center Part 1, and 270 271 Ocean View Center Part 2 Precincts and part of the St. Andrew's Precinct.

272 Third. 296 Fourth.
