| 10       | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:   |
| 11       | 1. That § 63.2-703 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:  |
| 12       | § 63.2-703. Faith-based and community initiatives; responsibilities of Department.   |
| 13       | A. The General Assembly finds that faith-based, volunteer, private and community organizations   |
| 14<br>15 | make significant contributions to the welfare of our society and constitute an underutilized and<br>underrepresented reservoir of assistance for social programs, and special efforts to increase utilization of |
| 16       | faith-based, volunteer, private and community organizations will enhance the Commonwealth's ability to   |
| 17       | carry out human welfare programs. To carry out these initiatives, <i>there is hereby established within</i> the  |
| 18       | Department of Social Services an Office of Faith-Based Community Services. In order to assist  |
| 19       | faith-based organizations in finding ways to cooperate with government agencies in order to improve  |
| 20       | service delivery, the Office shall:shall have the following responsibilities:  |
| 21       | 1. Lead and facilitate meetings as necessary, with faith-based, volunteer, private and community   |
| 22<br>23 | organizations for the purpose of sharing information to help carry out human welfare programs in Virginia;   |
| 23<br>24 | 2. Encourage conferences and meetings at the community level for faith-based, volunteer, private and   |
| 25       | community organizations, as needed;  |
| 26       | 3. Provide procurement and funding information to faith-based, volunteer, private and community  |
| 27       | organizations, as needed;  |
| 28       | 4. Provide information regarding faith-based and community initiatives and other information the   |
| 29<br>30 | Department may deem appropriate, to faith-based, volunteer, private and community organizations, and other state agencies whose missions may be enhanced by increased awareness of such initiatives and          |

| 32       | 5. Encourage the development and maintenance of a statewide network of local liaisons to assist in   |
| 33       | the dissemination of information and assistance;   |
| 34       | 6. Develop a statewide list of available faith-based, volunteer, private and community organizations.  |
| 35       | Such statewide list shall be made available to the public through the Department's website;  |
