9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 2.2-409 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 2.2-409. Secretary of the Commonwealth.
12	A. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall charge the following fees for services rendered in his
13	office to be paid by the person for whom the service is rendered at the time it is done:
14	For a testimonial, including seal tax \$10.00
15	For a copy of any paper, if on one sheet 1.00
16	And for each sheet after the first
17	For issuing a commission to a commissioner in another state
18	For power of attorney for nonresident insurers, contractors 3.00
19	For service of process on parties, each defendant
20	For service of process on reciprocal insurers
21	For registration of name, badge and insignia
22	For affixing the Seal of the Commonwealth 2.00
23	For issuing a commission to a notary for the Commonwealth at large, including
24 25	seal tax
26 26	for recording similar papers.
27	B. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A relating to the fee for testimonials, including seal
28	tax, the Secretary shall waive additional fees for a person submitting multiple documents for testimonial

29 seals required by a foreign country as part of an international adoption process relating to a particular child or children under the following conditions: the person submitting the documents provides proof to the Secretary (i) of having paid \$200 for testimonials relating to the specific adoption and (ii) that the additional testimonials relate to the same child or children. 30 31
