

1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to provide for a referendum in Page County on the election of the school board for staggered*
3 *four-year terms.*

5 Approved

6 Whereas, the voters of Page County in a November 2002 election approved the biennial election of
7 the board of supervisors for staggered four-year terms; and

8 Whereas, there has been confusion whether that election also reflected approval of the biennial
9 election of the school board for staggered four-year terms, and an election on that issue is required to
10 resolve this issue; now, therefore,

11 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

12 1. § 1. *The officials conducting the November 7, 2006, election in Page County shall conduct a*
13 *referendum on that date in the County to poll the voters on the question of whether they favor the*
14 *biennial election of school board members for staggered four-year terms.*

15 *The question on the ballot shall be:*

16 *"Shall members of the County School Board be elected biennially for staggered four-year terms?"*

17 *The ballots shall be prepared and voted, the referendum shall be conducted, and the results shall be*
18 *ascertained and certified as provided in Article 5 (§ 24.2-681 et seq.) of Chapter 6 of Title 24.2 of the*
19 *Code of Virginia.*

20 *The electoral board shall cause notice of the election to be published in a newspaper of general*
21 *circulation in the County at least once in the period 45 to 60 days before the election.*

22 *If the voters approve the election of the school board biennially for staggered four-year terms at the*
23 *November 2006 election, the members from Districts 1 and 5 shall be elected at the November 2007*
24 *election for two-year terms and the members from Districts 2, 3, and 4 shall be elected for four-year*
25 *terms. Thereafter all members shall be elected for four-year terms.*
