The regular election officers shall conduct the election as provided by general law, insofar as is 16 applicable. The question shall be as follows: 17 "Question: Shall the City of Martinsville become a town?" 18 19 § 4. If it appears by the report certified by the secretary of the electoral board that a majority of the 20 qualified voters of the city are in favor of the transition from city to town status, the special court shall 21 enter the order granting town status in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 41 of Title 15.2. All other provisions of such chapter shall continue to be applicable.
