9 10	WHEREAS, each year this nation becomes more deeply in debt as its expenditures repeatedly exceed
11	available revenues and the current national debt is over \$8 trillion and represents more than \$27,000 in
12	debt per citizen; and
13	WHEREAS, the federal budget fails to reflect actual spending because of the exclusion of special
14	outlays, which are neither included in the budget nor subject to the legal public debt limit; and
15	WHEREAS, knowledgeable planning requires that the budget reflect all federal spending and that the
16	budget be in balance; and
17	WHEREAS, attempts to curtail federal spending, confine expenditures to available revenues, and
18	reduce the annual deficit have met with only limited success; and
19	WHEREAS, the requirement to balance the budget will promote responsibility at the federal level,
20	provide a check against unnecessary and costly appropriations, and reinforce efforts to bring about fiscal
21	integrity; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Congress of the United
23 24	States be urged to call a constitutional convention for the purpose of amending the Constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget; and, be it

2 6	to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate,

and the members of the Virginia Congressional Delegation so that they may be apprised of the sense ofthe General Assembly of Virginia in this matter.
