| 14 15 | Environmental Quality requires automobile owners to have their vehicles tested on a biennial basis; and |
| | WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Quality has recently promulgated regulations to |
| 16 | administer an on-road emissions testing program using remote sensing devices; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, such on-road testing can both prescreen clean vehicles to avoid traditional inspections |
