his adopted home; and

WHEREAS, an eminently inspired teacher and mentor of young people, Barry Murphy taughtcriminal justice at the Massanutten Military Academy; and

WHEREAS, Barry Murphy was a generous benefactor of the Humane Society and an enthusiastic
 supporter of the establishment of the Shenandoah Cultural Arts Center; and

WHEREAS, Barry Murphy served his community with dignity and ardent devotion and will be
 sorely missed and fondly remembered by his family, his numerous friends and admirers, and the citizens
 Shenandoah County; now, therefore, be it
