WHEREAS, as editor of *The Professional Journal*, Tara Perkinson reached out to other staff sections of NCSL in order to provide to members articles and other pertinent information regarding issues that impact the legislative process; and

WHEREAS, over the years, Tara Perkinson has served the ASLCS in numerous capacities, including as an appointed associate member and an elected associate member of the Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, a consummate professional and leader, Tara Perkinson will continue to serve as an exceptional Associate Vice-President of the ASLCS for 2005-2006; now, therefore, be it
