Summary/Purpose:** The bill would require the consent of the local governing body before the State Water Control Board issues, modifies, amends, or renews a certificate or permit for the discharge of sewage, industrial wastes, including stormwater from industrial sites, and other wastes into or adjacent to state waters.

**6. Fiscal impact:** The required consent could prolong some actions, which could result in higher public participation costs to the Department of Environmental Quality. However, any such additional costs are not likely to be significant.
