4. **Title** Local certification for waste discharge permits into local watershed protection districts

5. **Summary/Purpose:** The bill would provide that no application for a Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit authorizing direct or indirect discharge of stormwater runoff from a new municipal solid waste landfill into a local watershed protection district established and designated as such by city ordinance prior to January 1, 2006 shall be considered complete unless it contains certification from the local governing body of the city in which the discharge is to take place that the discharge is consistent with the city's ordinance establishing and designating the local watershed protection district. This provision would apply to applications for new or modified individual Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and for new or modified coverage under general Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits, but would not apply to any municipal solid waste landfill in operation on or before January 1, 2006. This provision would expire on July 1, 2026.
