4. Title Preservation of state-owned properties.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill requires the Department of Historic Resources to develop, on a biennial basis, a report on the stewardship of state-owned properties. The report shall include, but not be limited to, a priority list of the Commonwealth's most significant state-owned properties that are eligible for but not designated on the Virginia Landmarks Register and those properties that are threatened with the loss of historic integrity or functionality. Each agency that owns property included on the report shall consult with the Department to try and reach a consensus decision on designation of an unlisted property and on the general manner of addressing property needs in the case of a threatened historic property.

6. Fiscal Impact: According to the Department of Historic Resources (DHR), this legislation will have little or no fiscal impact. DHR will utilize existing resources to carry out the requirements of this legislation.
