5 6 WHEREAS, Senior Trooper-Agent Mark Daniel DeHart, an outstanding law-enforcement officer and 7 dedicated public servant, died on March 26, 2006; and 8 WHEREAS, Mark Daniel DeHart was born on July 27, 1962, in Martinsville, graduated from 9 Fieldale-Collinsville High School in 1980, and received a bachelor's degree in journalism from Radford 10 University in 1984; and WHEREAS, after completing his college education, Mark Daniel DeHart worked part-time as a 11 reporter for The News Journal in Radford; and 12 13 WHEREAS, aspiring to a career in law-enforcement, Mark Daniel DeHart joined the Virginia State Police in July 1985, worked as a trooper-trainee in Bristol, and entered the Virginia State Police 14 15 Academy on September 29, 1985; and WHEREAS, after graduation from the Academy on February 14, 1986, Trooper DeHart reported to 16 his first patrol assignment with the Virginia State Police Fairfax Division, which included duty in 17 Lorton, Herndon, and Centreville; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Trooper DeHart continued his distinguished career upon transferring to the Virginia 20 State Police Salem Division, serving the citizens of Roanoke County and Henry County; and 21 WHEREAS, a dedicated and extraordinary public servant, Mark DeHart achieved the rank of senior 22 trooper on November 11, 1995; and WHEREAS, on July 1, 2000, Senior Trooper DeHart transferred to the Special Operations Division 23 24 in Henry County and in 2004 was promoted to senior trooper-agent assigned to the Help Eliminate Auto 25 Theft (HEAT) unit; and WHEREAS, a respected law-enforcement officer with considerable expertise and experience, Senior 26 27 Trooper-Agent DeHart served as the HEAT program coordinator for western and southwest Virginia; 28 and WHEREAS. Senior Trooper-Agent DeHart will be sorely missed by his family, his numerous friends 29 30 and admirers, his fellow troopers, and the citizens of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it

the passing of an outstanding public servant and fine Virginian, Mark Daniel DeHart; and, be it
