Charlottesville; and

excellent in the Single A Division at the 22nd North Stafford Marching Band Invitational state
competition and received 2nd place auxiliary, 2nd place marching, 2nd place for general effect, 1st place
percussion, and 2nd place band awards in the prestigious event; and

WHEREAS, the Culpeper County High School Band was a superior entry in the Charlottesville Marching Band Competition in October 2005 and received an overall rating of superior in the Single A Division and received 1st place drum major, 1st place marching, 1st place general effect, 1st place auxiliary, 1st place music, and 1st place band awards; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Culpeper County High School Band program is due to the tremendous efforts of band director Duane Clore and assistant director Adam Roach, the enthusiastic and talented members of the Culpeper County High School Band, the enthusiastic support of family
