WHEREAS, committed to improving the quality of life of her neighbors, Claudia Caldwell gave her
 time and immense talents to the Martinsville-Henry County Mental Health Association, the Association
 for Retarded Citizens, Anchor House, and FOCUS; and

WHEREAS, Claudia Caldwell served as assistant secretary for Voter Registration and was a
 dedicated member of the Voters League, the Criminal Justice Committee of West Piedmont Planning
