13	§ 2.2-4312.1. Required disclosure of the location where services to be performed under the contract.
14	A. State public bodies shall include in all solicitations for the purchase of services from
15	nongovernmental contractors a requirement that the prospective vendors disclose the location where
16	services will be performed under the contract, including any subcontracts, and whether any services
17	under the contract, including any subcontracts, are anticipated to be performed outside of the United
18 19	States. In awarding the contract or evaluating the bid or offer, the public body may consider the disclosure of the prospective worder and the commonwealth and its sitizand
20	<i>disclosure of the prospective vendor and the economic impact to the Commonwealth and its citizens.</i> <i>B. If the public body awards the contract based upon a prospective vendor's disclosure that the</i>
21	services under the contract will be performed in the United States, and the vendor subsequently changes
22	the location where the services are performed to a location outside of the United States, the vendor
23	shall be deemed in breach of the contract unless the public body makes a written determination that
24	circumstances required the change in location or termination of the contract would not be in the best
