| 11 | 1. That § 16.1-69.48:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 12 | § 16.1-69.48:1. Fixed fee for misdemeanors, traffic infractions and other violations in district court; |
| 13 | additional fees to be added. |
| 14 | A. Assessment of the fees provided for in this section shall be based on: (i) an appearance for court |
| 15 | hearing in which there has been a finding of guilty; (ii) a written appearance with waiver of court |
| 16 | hearing and entry of guilty plea; (iii) for a defendant failing to appear, a trial in his or her absence |
| 17 18 | resulting in a finding of guilty; (iv) an appearance for court hearing in which the court requires that the defendant successfully complete traffic school or a driver improvement clinic, in lieu of a finding of |
| 10 19 | guilty; or (v) a deferral of proceedings pursuant to §§ 4.1-305, 16.1-278.8, 16.1-278.9, 18.2-57.3, |
| 20 | 18.2-251 or $19.2-303.2$. |
| $\overline{21}$ | In addition to any other fee prescribed by this section, a fee of \$20 shall be taxed as costs whenever |
| 22 | a defendant fails to appear, unless, after a hearing requested by such person, good cause is shown for |
| 23 | such failure to appear. No defendant with multiple charges arising from a single incident shall be taxed |
| 24 | the applicable fixed fee provided in subsection B, C, or D of this section more than once for a single |
