11	1. That § 46.2-344 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-344. Temporary driver's permit.
13	The Department, upon determining, after an examination, that an applicant is mentally, physically,
14	and otherwise qualified to receive a license, may issue to him a temporary driver's permit entitling him,
15	while having the permit in his immediate possession, to drive a motor vehicle on the highways for a
16	period of ninety days, pending the issuance to such person of a driver's license.
