A BILL to amend and reenact § 24.2-304.02 of the Code of Virginia, relating to composition of certain House of Delegates districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**1. That § 24.2-304.02 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 24.2-304.02. House of Delegates districts; composition of certain districts.

Subject to the provisions of subsections A, B, and C of § 24.2-304.01, the following House of Delegates districts shall be comprised as follows. References to precincts and parts of precincts are to precincts as listed in the 2000 Census reports.

First. All of Lee and Scott Counties; part of Washington County comprised of the Burson Place, Mendota, Valley Institute, Wallace Part 3, and Wallace Part 1 Precincts and part of the Greendale Precinct; and part of Wise County comprised of the East Stone Gap and Clinch Valley Precincts and part of the Big Stone Gap Precinct.

Second. All of Dickenson County; all of the City of Norton; part of Russell County comprised of the Copper Creek, Moccasin, South Castlewood, Cleveland, Dante, North Castlewood, Cooks Mill, Daughertys, ~~Elk Garden~~, and Lebanon Precincts and part of the ~~Honaker~~ *Honaker* Elk Garden Precinct; and part of Wise County comprised of the Appalachia, Dorchester, Guest River, West Pound, North Coeburn, Wise, East Pound, South Coeburn, and St. Paul Precincts and part of the Big Stone Gap Precinct.

Third. All of Buchanan County; part of Russell County comprised of the Honaker, Drill, and Swords Creek Precincts and part of the Elk Garden Precinct; and part of Tazewell County comprised of the Tip Top, Amonate, Bishop, Adria, Gap Store, Bandy, Abbs Valley 101/Boissevain 103/Falls Mills 104/Pocahontas 106, Burkes Garden, Clear Fork, Freestone, Jeffersonville, Thompson Valley, Cedar Bluff, Baptist Valley, Wardell, Pounding Mill, Richlands, Jewell Ridge, and Raven Precincts.

Sixth. All of Bland County; part of Giles County comprised of the Glen Lyn, Rich Creek, Narrows, Pearisburg, Staffordsville, White Gate, Sugar Run, Eggleston, Pembroke, and Hatfield Precincts; part of Pulaski County comprised of the Belspring, New River, West Cloyd, Draper, South Pulaski, Newbern, Massie, Walker, and Robinson Precincts and part of the Dublin Precinct; part of Tazewell County comprised of the Springville and Graham Precincts; and part of Wythe County comprised of the Royal Oak, Evansham, Pine Ridge, Spiller, Withers, and Max Meadows Precincts and part of the Evergreen Precinct.

Seventh. All of the City of Radford; part of Montgomery County comprised of the B-2, B-3, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, D-1, D-2, D-3 Part 1, D-4, D-5, E-1, and E-2 Precincts; part of Pulaski County comprised of the Hiwasee 302/Snowville 304 Precinct and part of the Dublin Precinct; and Montgomery A.

Seventeenth. Part of Botetourt County comprised of parts of the Amsterdam, Cloverdale, Troutville, Mill Creek, and Coyner Springs Precincts; part of Roanoke County comprised of the Plantation, Burlington, Mountain View, Bonsack, Hollins, Mount Pleasant, Ogden, Clearbrook, and Hunting Hills Precincts and part of the Lindenwood Precinct; and part of the City of Roanoke comprised of the Jefferson-Riverdale, Williamson Road 6, Monterey, Raleigh Court 2, Raleigh Court 3, Raleigh Court 4, Raleigh Court 5, Fishburn Park, Grandin Court, South Roanoke 2, Lee-Hi, and Garden City Precincts and part of the South Roanoke 1 Precinct.

Nineteenth. All of the City of Bedford; part of Bedford County comprised of the Stewartsville, Hardy, Otter Hill, Cove, Big Island, Sedalia, Kelso, Boonsboro, Montvale, Shady Grove, Thaxton, Goode, Liberty High School, and Sign Rock Precincts and parts of the Forest and Jefferson Precincts; and part of Botetourt County comprised of the Asbury, Town Hall, Blue Ridge, Rainbow Forest, Roaring Run, Buchanan 301/Springwood 304, Courthouse, Eagle Rock, Glen Wilton, and Oriskany Precincts and parts of the Amsterdam, Cloverdale, Troutville, Mill Creek, and Coyner Springs Precincts.

Twenty-second. All of Campbell County; and part of Bedford County comprised of the Chamblissburg, Staunton River, Moneta, Mountain View, New London, Walton's Store, White House, and Huddleston Precincts and parts of the Forest and Jefferson Precincts.

Twenty-third. All of the City of Lynchburg; and part of Amherst County comprised of the Wright Shop and Coolwell Precincts and part of the Amelon and Monroe Precincts.

71 Thirty-first. Part of Fauquier County comprised of the Kettle Run, Catlett, Casanova, and New
72 Baltimore Precincts and part of the Baldwin Ridge Precinct; and part of Prince William County
73 comprised of the Park, Saunders, Enterprise, Coles, King, Lodge, Dale, Neabsco, Godwin, and Bel Air
74 Precincts and parts of the Bethel, Chinn, Minnieville, Quantico and Washington-Reid Precincts.

75 Forty-seventh. Part of Arlington County comprised of the Ashton Heights, Ballston, Barcroft,
76 Clarendon, Lyon Park, Overlee Knolls, Westover, Arlington Forest, Fillmore, Jefferson, Dominion Hills,
77 Lexington, Arlington View, Ashlawn, Virginia Square, and Woodbury Precincts and part of the Glen
78 Carlyn Precinct.

79 Forty-ninth. Part of the City of Alexandria comprised of the Cora Kelly Center and Mt. Vernon
80 Recreation Center Precincts; part of Arlington County comprised of the Arlington, Columbia, Claremont,

97 Ivy, Monticello, Keswick, Stony Point, Hollymead, Free Union, and Earlysville Precincts and parts of
98 the Agnor-Hurt, Jack Jouett, Scottsville, Cale, Free Bridge, University Hall, and Crozet Precincts; part of
99 Fluvanna County comprised of the Palmyra and Rivanna Precincts and part of the Cunningham Precinct;
100 and part of Orange County comprised of parts of the One West and Two West Precincts.

112 County comprised of the Plymouth, Brown's Store, McCoy Ghee's Store, Arrowhead Gun Club, Pleasant
113 Grove, Reedy Creek, Peoples Community Center, Meherrin Fire Dept, and Courthouse Precincts; and
114 part of Nottoway County comprised of Precinct 1-2, Precinct 2-1, Precinct 2-2, Precinct 3-2, Precinct
115 4-1, Precinct 4-2, Precinct 5-1, and Precinct 3-1 Part 1.

116 Sixty-second. Part of Chesterfield County comprised of the Enon, Point Of Rocks, and Salem Church

118 Sandston, Seven Pines, Whitlocks, and Dorey Precincts; part of the City of Hopewell comprised of the
119 Ward 3, Ward 4, and Ward 5 Precincts and parts of the Ward 1, Ward 6, and Ward 7 Precincts; and
120 part of Prince George County comprised of the Richard Bland College, Templeton, Union Branch,

121 Rives, Blackwater, Brandon, Jefferson Park, and Bland Precincts and part of the Courts Building
122 Precinct.

123 Sixty-fourth. All of Surry County; all of the City of Williamsburg; part of the City of Franklin
124 comprised of part of Precinct 1-1; part of Isle of Wight County comprised of the Smithfield, Carrollton,
125 Rushmere, Pons, Courthouse, Windsor, Orbit, Walters, Carrsville, and Zuni Precincts; part of James City
126 County comprised of the Jamestown A, Jamestown B, and Jamestown C Precincts and parts of the
127 Berkeley A, Berkeley B, Powhatan A, Powhatan B, and Roberts A Part 1 Precincts; and part of
128 Southampton County comprised of the Hunterdale and Sedley Precincts.

129 Seventy-fourth. All of Charles City County; part of Henrico County comprised of the Adams, Azalea,
130 Bloomingdale, Brook Hill, Canterbury, Chamberlayne, East Highland Park, Fairfield, Glen Lea,
131 Greenwood, Highland Gardens, Hungary, Longdale, Randolph, Ratcliffe, Upham, Wilkinson, Yellow
132 Tavern, Maplewood, Chipplegate, Landmark, Cedar Fork, Donahoe, Elko, Fairmount, Highland Springs,
133 and Pleasants Precincts; part of the City of Hopewell comprised of the Ward 2 Precinct and parts of the
134 Ward 1, Ward 6, and Ward 7 Precincts; part of the City of Richmond comprised of the 604 Precinct;
135 and part of Prince George County comprised of part of the Courts Building Precinct.

136 Seventy-fifth. All of Greensville and Sussex Counties; all of the City of Emporia; part of Brunswick
137 County comprised of the Edgerton, Fitzhugh, Alberta, Danielstown, Elmore, Seymour, Sturgeon, King's
138 Store, and Lawrenceville Precincts and part of the Brodnax and Rock Store Precincts; part of the City of
139 Franklin comprised of Precinct 2-1, Precinct 3-1, Precinct 4-1, Precinct 5-1, and Precinct 6-1 and part of
140 Precinct 1-1; part of Isle of Wight County comprised of the Camps Mill Precinct; part of Lunenburg
141 County comprised of the Parham's Store and Hound's Creek Precincts; and part of Southampton County
142 comprised of the Berlin, Ivor, Boykins, Branchville, Capron, Sebrell, Drewryville, Forks-of-the-River,
143 Courtland, Blackwater River, and Newsoms Precincts.

144 Seventy-sixth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Churchland, Gilmerton, Jolliff One,
145 Fellowship Baptist Church, Silverwood, Bailey Creek, Lake Drummond, John T. West, Deep Creek, and
146 Nansemond Precincts; and part of the City of Suffolk comprised of the Driver, Ebenezer, Chuckatuck,
147 King's Fork, Whaleyville, Holland, Holy Neck, Lakeside, Elephant's Fork, and Lake Meade Precincts
148 and parts of the Cypress Chapel, Harbour View, Kilby's Mill, Nansemond River, Olde Towne, and
149 Yeates Precincts.

150 Seventy-seventh. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Camelot, Oscar Smith School,
151 Geneva Park, Georgetown, E. W. Chittum School, St. Julians, Sunray I, South Norfolk Fire Station,
152 Carver School, Providence Church of Christ, Westover, Sunray II, and South Norfolk Recreation
153 Precincts and parts of the Crestwood and Oak Grove Precincts; and part of the City of Suffolk
154 comprised of the White Marsh, John F. Kennedy, Airport, and Hollywood Precincts and parts of the
155 Cypress Chapel, Kilby's Mill, and Olde Towne Precincts.

156 Seventy-eighth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Great Bridge, Greenbrier, B. M.
157 Williams School, Hickory Grove, Hickory Middle School, Great Bridge Middle School, Bridgetown,
158 River Birch, Parkways, Pleasant Crossing, and Bells Mill II Precincts and parts of the Crestwood and
159 Oak Grove Precincts.

160 Seventy-ninth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Taylor Road Fire Station Precinct;
161 part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Larchmont Library and Larchmont Recreation Center
162 Precincts and parts of the Canterbury, Titustown Center, and Zion Grace Precincts; part of the City of
163 Portsmouth comprised of the Ten, Eleven, Twenty-Two, Twenty-Three, Twenty-Four, Twenty-Five,
164 Thirty, Thirty-Three, Thirty-Four, Thirty-Five, Thirty-Six, and Thirty-Seven/Thirty-Eight Precincts; and
165 part of the City of Suffolk comprised of parts of the Harbor View, Nansemond River, and Yeates
166 Precincts.

167 Eighty-seventh. Part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Northside, Crossroads, Therapeutic
168 Center, Wesley, Bayview United, East Ocean View, Larrymore, Little Creek, Oceanair, Tarrallton, Third
169 Presbyterian, and Ocean View Center Part 2 Precincts and parts of the Azalea Gardens, Barron Black,
170 Bayview School, Granby, Ocean View Center Part 1, Ocean View School, Titustown Center, Tucker
171 House and Zion Grace Precincts.

172 Eighty-ninth. Part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Ghent Square, Immanuel, Lafayette
173 Library, Lafayette Presbyterian, Lambert's Point, Maury, Park Place, Stuart, Suburban Park, Willard,
174 Ballentine, Tanner's Creek, Coleman Place School, Lafayette-Winona, Lindenwood, Monroe, Norview
175 Methodist, Norview Recreation Center, Rosemont, Sherwood School, and Young Park Precincts and
176 parts of the Granby, Hunton Y, Sherwood Rec Center Part 2, and Tucker House Precincts.

177 Ninetieth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Indian River, Norfolk Highlands,
178 Oaklette, and Tanglewood Precincts; part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Bowling Park, Union
179 Chapel, Brambleton, Campostella, Chesterfield, Coleman Place Presbyterian, Easton, Fairlawn, Houston,
180 Ingleside, Poplar Halls, and Sherwood Rec Center Part 1 Precincts and parts of the Azalea Gardens,
181 Barron Black, and Sherwood Rec Center Part 2 Precincts; and part of the City of Virginia Beach

182 comprised of the Baker Precinct.

183 Ninety-seventh. All of New Kent County; part of Caroline County comprised of the Madison and
184 Reedy Church Precincts and parts of the Mattaponi and Woodford Precincts; part of Hanover County
185 comprised of the Battlefield, Old Church, Cold Harbor, Black Creek, Studley, and Stonewall Jackson
186 Precincts and part of the Rural Point 502/Newman 503 Precinct; part of Henrico County comprised of
187 the Chickahominy, Nine Mile, and Antioch Precincts; part of King and Queen County comprised of the
188 Owenton and Clark's Precincts; part of King William County comprised of the Second-B, Third, Fourth
189 and Fifth Precincts and part of the Second-A Precinct; and part of Spotsylvania County comprised of the
190 Partlow and Blaydes Corner Precincts.

191 Ninety-eighth. All of Essex, Gloucester, Mathews, and Middlesex Counties; part of King and Queen
192 County comprised of the Shackelford's, Courthouse, and Old Mill Precincts; and part of King William
193 County comprised of the First Precinct and part of the Second-A Precinct.

194 Ninety-ninth. All of King George, Lancaster, Northumberland, Richmond, and Westmoreland
195 Counties; and part of Caroline County comprised of the Bowling Green and Port Royal Precincts and
196 parts of the Mattaponi and Woodford Precincts.

197 All other House of Delegates districts shall be comprised as provided in § 24.2-304.01.

198 **2. That the effect of the first enactment shall be to supersede certain segments of the boundary**
199 **line between the Second and Third House of Delegates districts as follows:**

200 The segment of the boundary between the Second and Third House of Delegates districts within
201 Russell County beginning at the point where an unnamed tributary (the boundary between census
202 blocks 511679905001024 and 511679905001025) of Stillhouse Branch intersects New Garden Road
203 (State Route 692), then east on New Garden Road to State Route 651, south on State Route 651 to
204 Hubbard Branch, south on Hubbard Branch to the Clinch River, east on the Clinch River to
205 Little River, and east on Little River to its intersection with State Route 636 is superseded by a
206 segment beginning at the point where an unnamed tributary (the boundary between census blocks
207 511679905001024 and 511679905001025) of Stillhouse Branch intersects New Garden Road (State
208 Route 692), then south on the unnamed tributary to its headwaters, southwest on a line extended
209 to an unidentified ridge line, south on said ridge line to a line extended from the headwaters of an
210 unnamed tributary of the Clinch River, south on said line to the headwaters of the unnamed creek
211 (said tributaries, extension, and ridge lines being the boundary between census blocks
212 511679902005000 and 511679902005001), southwest on the unnamed creek to the Clinch River,
213 southeast on the Clinch River to Pucketts Branch, southeast on Pucketts Branch to its headwaters,
214 southeast on a line extended to the crest of River Mountain, east on the ridge lines of River
215 Mountain and The Doubles Mountain to State Highway 80, south on State Highway 80 to United
216 States Highway 19, east on United States Highway 19 to its intersection with State Route 644,
217 north on a straight line to the headwaters of Mill Branch, northeast in a straight line to the
218 intersection of State Route 636 and State Route 640, and then north on State Route 636 to Little
219 River.
