9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 33.1-23.03:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 33.1-23.03:1. Transportation Trust Fund.
13	There is hereby created in the Department of the Treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known
14	as the Transportation Trust Fund, consisting of:
15	1. Funds remaining for highway construction purposes, among the several highway systems pursuant
16	to § 33.1-23.1.
17	2. [Repealed.]
18	3. The additional revenues generated by enactments of Chapters 11, 12 and 15 of the Acts of
19	Assembly, 1986 Special Session, and designated for this fund.
20	4. Tolls and other revenues derived from the projects financed or refinanced pursuant to this title
21	which are payable into the state treasury and tolls and other revenues derived from other transportation
22	projects, which may include upon the request of the applicable appointed governing body, as soon as
23	their obligations have been satisfied, such tolls and revenue derived for transportation projects pursuant
24 25	to § 33.1-253 (Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel District) and § 33.1-320 (Richmond Metropolitan
25 26	Authority) or if the appointed governing body requests refunding or advanced refunding by the Board and such refunding or advanced refunding is approved by the General Assembly. Such funds shall be
20 27	held in separate subaccounts of the Transportation Trust Fund to the extent required by law or the
28	Board.
<b>2</b> 9	5. Tolls and other revenues derived from the Richmond-Petersburg Turnpike, provided that such
30	funds shall be held in a separate subaccount of the Transportation Trust Fund and allocated as set forth
31	in Chapter 574 of the Acts of Assembly of 1983 until expiration of that Act.
32	6. Such other funds as may be appropriated by the General Assembly from time to time, and
33	designated for this fund.
34	7. All interest, dividends and appreciation which may accrue to the Transportation Trust Fund and
35	the Highway Maintenance and Construction Fund, except that interest on funds becoming part of the
36	Transportation Trust Fund under subdivision 1 and the Highway Maintenance and Construction Fund
37	shall not become part of the Transportation Trust Fund until July 1, 1988.
38	8. All amounts required by contract to be paid over to the Transportation Trust Fund.
39 40	9. After any required deposits to the Revenue Stabilization Fund pursuant to § 2.2-1829 and to the Vincinia Water Quality Improvement Fund pursuant to $\frac{5}{5}$ 10.1.2128, 75% of any permission and the
40 41	Virginia Water Quality Improvement Fund pursuant to § 10.1-2128, 75% of any remaining annual general fund revenue collections that are in excess of the official estimates in the general appropriation
41	act and 75% of any remaining unreserved general fund balance at the close of each fiscal year whose
42 43	reappropriation is not required in the general appropriation act.
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
