8 WHEREAS, in 1932 the General Assembly gave Virginia motor vehicle inspectors the power to
9 enforce the Criminal Code of the Commonwealth and the Motor Vehicle Code, and these inspectors,
10 later identified as troopers, became the Virginia Department of State Police; and

11 WHEREAS, that same year the General Assembly established a system of motor vehicle safety 12 inspections which became a model for the nation and the Virginia Department of State Police was 13 issued its first fleet of enforcement vehicles, including motorcycles; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of State Police, independent yet supportive of other
 law-enforcement and criminal justice agencies, continues to be a professional, responsive, state-of-the-art
 public safety agency that provides patrol and investigative services to the citizens of the Commonwealth
 of Virginia and its visitors; and

18 WHEREAS, the troopers of the Virginia Department of State Police daily risk their lives in the
19 performance of their duties in order to fulfill their pledge to serve and protect the Commonwealth's
